

Advancing to the Championship

- 1. Each division offered at a regional contest will have its own quota for the number teams advancing to the Championship.
- 2. Quotas are based on the actual number of teams that compete in a division at a regional contest, not the number that register.
- 3. If a qualifying team is unable to attend the Championship, the opportunity to advance is awarded to the next highest scoring team in that division.
- 4. The wildcard teams are identified at the discretion of the Regional Contest Organizer. A wildcard team could be chosen by whichever team receives the People Choice Award or selected by a Judges Panel. The Regional Contest Organizer has final say in the team(s) selected for wildcard spots.
- 5. Regional Contest Quotas:

Number of Teams Competing in Regional Contest Division	Number of Teams Advancing to Championship
Up to 10 Teams	Top 3 Teams
11 to 20 Teams	Top 4 Teams + 1 Wildcard Team
21 to 30 Teams	Top 5 Teams + 2 Wildcard Team
31 or More Teams	Top 6 Teams + 3 Wildcard Team

- 6. The Regional Contest Organizer is responsible for completing and submitting the Regional Contest Advancing Team Forms within two weeks of completing the regional contest.
- 7. After receiving the Regional Contest Advancing Team Forms, the Minnesota State Engineering Center of Excellence will contact the teams qualifying for the Championship and provide them with relevant information.
